Applicants must have a Doctoral degree (PhD) or equivalent in a relevant field. The successful candidate will be employed by the NAOJ, and will be stationed at Kindai University. In case the PI of the project (Professor Inoue) moves to another university or institute, the successful candidate is expected to accompany the PI.
